**Rounds:** **Saturday: UK Record Status** - Western, Western 50, Western 40, Western 30 rounds. We also offer a “Jollys Western 20” round (4 dozen arrows at 20 yards, and 4 dozen at 15 yards) for novice juniors who are not confident at shooting the longer rounds but priority will be given to archers shooting the standard Western rounds. The Western 20 round will not qualify for the SCAYT Youth Tour.

**Senior archers are welcome to enter the standard Western rounds but places will not be allocated until after the closing date.**

**Sunday:** Western, Western 50, Western 40, Western 30 rounds. - **Seniors and Under 18's.**

**Shooting Rules** AGB rules in place at the time of the shoot will be applied.

**Awards:** **Both days:** Individual awards according to entries. Competitors are welcome to shoot a shorter, non-age appropriate, round but the scores of any Juniors doing so will not be eligible for the SCAYT.

**Sunday only:**

Recurve Club Team - Top three highest scoring archers from a club to include **at least** one Woman or one Under 18 (All shooting their age appropriate round)

Longbow Club Team, Recurve Barebow Club Team and Compound Club Teams - Top two highest scoring archers from a club in each bow category (All shooting their age appropriate round)

**Entry Fee:** Over 18's £10.00, Under 18's £6.00 per day. Places will not be reserved without payment.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Archery GB cards must be produced if requested and Rule 307 (Dress regulations) will apply.
2. The organiser reserves the right to modify the target lists on the day.
3. Please ensure the organiser is aware of any special requirements or hearing impairment you may have. Archers who are unable to get to the target are requested, if possible, to arrange for an agent to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please let the organiser know.
4. In line with the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anybody wishing to take photographs at this event must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival and provide proof of identity. If parents/carers have any concerns about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organiser.
5. General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), Please note that when you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
6. Liability: Although every reasonable attempt will be made to ensure archers have an enjoyable visit to our venue, Jolly Archers cannot accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained whilst competing in or attending this event. Standard Archery GB insurance cover is in place.
7. An equipment inspection will be held prior to the start of the shoot.
8. For a target list and results sheet please provide an email address or include 2 stamped, addressed C5 envelopes with this entry form. Further copies of this form may be downloaded from our web-site: [www.jollyarchers.org.uk](http://www.jollyarchers.org.uk). The availability of spaces, target lists and the results will be posted on our web-site.
9. Animals, other than assistance animals such as guide dogs are not permitted. Please advise the Tournament Organiser if you plan to bring an assistance animal.
10. Ample parking is available. These with limited mobility should contact the organiser in advance to discuss parking options.
11. Lost arrows should be reported to a judge or a member of the field party. Please remember to inform them should you subsequently find the arrow.
12. Age Groups - Men, Women, Under 18 Men, Under 18 Women, Under 16 Men, Under 16 Women, Under 15 Men, Under 15 Women, Under 14 Men, Under 14 Women, Under 12 men and Under 12 Women. An archer may compete in a junior age group where the tournament takes place up to and in the year of their birthday prior to the limit on the category e.g. if they turned 17 in the year of the shoot they can complete in an U18 category but they cannot turn 18 in that year). We are not including the Under 21 or 50+ age groups for this years shoot but will be collecting data from the entry forms to inform future decisions on these groups.
