Archery in Jolly Archers is governed by the Archery GB Rules of Shooting. In addition, we have Jollys Rules which include sections on Shooting, and Safety. All members should make themselves familiar with these rules to ensure we shoot in an enjoyable and safe environment

We are fortunate that we have access to our range 24/7. Shooting can and does take place throughout the week. Here are some of the more popular times

If you wish to shoot a scoring round the detailed requirements are shown in Jollys Archers Rules-Shooting, Rules15-18.

#### Weekday Mornings

When the weather is decent there will normally be members shooting during the morning

#### Wednesday Evening

The evening is for general shooting. Some archers get together to shoot a round, some to practice, some shoot for fun and some just come along for a natter! The committee will try to ensure that the container will be open from 5.30pm to at least 7.30pm for those new members without keys. Distances are generally limited to 60 yards to ensure all archers are not inconvenienced. If a longer distance is shot archers should not delay others.

#### Saturday Morning

The morning is for general shooting. Some get together to shoot a round, some practice, some shoot for fun and some just come along for a natter!

Coaching, Beginners' Courses, and Have-a-Go's will be conducted independently on the Coaching Range.

The committee will ensure that the container will be open from 10.00am to at least 12.00pm for those without keys. Distances are generally restricted to 60 yards to ensure all archers are not inconvenienced. If a longer distance is shot archers should not delay others.

#### Sunday-Designated Shooting calendar/Trophy Shoots

To allow archers the opportunity to shoot rounds in the best possible conditions there is a shooting calendar giving a defined start time and the rounds to be shot on Sunday during the outdoor season. Other rounds, or no round, can be shot but the start time is the same for all archers.

Latecomers may be able to join in with a round that has already commenced if there is space on a boss that has already been set up and that the archers on that target are willing for that archer to join them.
