JOLLY ARCHERS DATA PROTECTION

Data Protection Regulations 2018 require us to inform you of how your information is used.

- 1) The Club keeps your information in both paper and electronic form. It will take all reasonable steps to ensure that membership data is held securely.

- 3) Our prime communication method with members is email, although other methods are often required to be used.
- 4) Information such as name, gender, and age group (if applicable) and, of course, scores achieved for rounds shot will be recorded to provide a shooting history of the member's archery. This data is used to enable the analysis of personal scores that is fundamental to the activities of an archery club in producing handicaps, classifications, badge awards, competition results, trophy winners and any other shooting awards that may be offered. Should you be successful in setting club records and/or winning trophies your achievements will be kept and so become part of the club's history. Publication of such results will mainly be within the club but may also be advised to ArcheryGB, regional and county archery organisations, clubs we may be competing with, the local press and our digital media platforms and website.
- 5) The data will not be shared with any person/body for marketing purposes.
- 6) When you become a member of or renew your membership with Jolly Archers you will automatically be registered as a member of Archery GB and the relevant County and Region, unless Jolly Archers is your second club and you are already registered as a member of ArcheryGB and a relevant County and Region. We will provide Archery GB with the data you provide on this form, which they will use to enable access to an online portal for you (<https://agb.sport80.com>) which, amongst other things, allows you to set and amend your privacy settings.
